How to get to Oyado Ishicho Inn:

From JR Kyoto station it is a 15-minute taxi ride. From Marutamachi station on the Keihan Dentetsu line it is a 5-minute walk. (It is a 20-minute walk from the inn to the tournament site.)

Every room is Japanese style. There are no beds, only futons. The rooms hold from 5 to 8 people. The men's and women's rooms are separate from each other. Each room is equipped with a T.V., phone, hairdryer, Western style toilet, air conditioner, a bath (body soap and shampoo/rinse included), towels, yukata (Japanese bathrobe), slippers and a safe deposit box.

Check-in begins at 3:00 p.m. Checkout is by 10:00 a.m.

Cost for one night stay is 7,350 yen per night (breakfast included) or 6,300 yen per night (breakfast not included). Breakfast will be Japanese style only. (Rice, miso soup, eggs, fried fish, pickled vegetables and seaweed) Those choosing not to have breakfast at the inn will be able to eat at one of the many restaurants located near the inn.

You are to request a room as a member of a group, not individually. The group must also make the payment for the room. Payments by individuals for their own personal stay are not possible.

There may be a cancellation fee for cancellations made just before the reserved date of stay. When the representative of the group pays for the room, the cancellation fee must also be paid at that time. A cancellation fee will be charged if a cancellation is made within 30 days before the reserved date.
